

ACTIVITY OPERATING GUIDELINES STREET TRIX



DESCRIPTION:

Learning magic tricks is not only tremendous fun, it also has many hidden benefits. Street Trix delivers in more ways than one.

OPERATION:

The activity has been designed as a plug and play solution, there will be an on screen demonstration followed by built in practice sessions with a countdown clock (there should be no reason to stop the video during the activity, unless you wish to extend the practice session time, which should be at the discretion of the facilitator) then simply choose either one of the individual levels or play the full version and away you go!

PRE ACTIVITY SETUP:


Make sure there are enough chairs for the participants to be able to sit comfortably to watch the activity. Ensure there are tables available to practice the tricks on.


TECHNICAL SET UP:

The activity requires a screen visible to the participants, laptop and speakers. Please refer to the technical help section on the iDEA website for more information.

CHILD PARTICIPANT RATIOS:

The recommended adult: child ratio for this activity is as follows;





FACILITATOR TIPS AND TRICKS:

To increase user engagement of this activity ideally the facilitator should be confident in performing all of the tricks demonstrated, this will help to provide further help and instruction to the participants (do this by watching the video in advance of the session and practice).

To enhance the activity certain participants could be selected to perform the tricks to the rest of the group at the end of the session.

Planning Your Sessions:

Welcome the participants and give them an introduction to the activity. You should also close the session with a recap and promotion of the next session.

Allow sufficient time for signing in and out participants, preparing the venue, prepping the equipment and scheduling water breaks etc. Taking the above into consideration means that 1 activity level can last for 30 minutes or 2 levels 1 hour. As an example L1 and L2, L1 and L3, L2 and L3 repeated twice could build into a 6-week course.

You can also combine similar activities to build a course.

HEALTH AND SAFETY:

- Never leave electrical equipment unattended.
- Ensure the area is clear and clean and free from trip hazards before the activity starts.
